Tim Pawlowski studied Economics at the University of Cologne as well as Sport Management at the German Sport University where he also earned his Ph.D. in 2009. In 2012 he joined the University of Tübingen as Full Professor for Sport Economics (Chair in Sport Economics, Sport Management and Media Research). Tim's research is focused on the economics of league competitions, the economic analysis of sports demand as well as the financing of sport systems and was supported with research grants from the German Research Foundation (DFG), UEFA and FIFA. Amongst others, he was Principal Investigator in research projects for the Federal Ministry of Finance in Germany, Major League Soccer (MLS) and Hamburger Sport-Verein (HSV) as well as guest speaker invited by the United Nations Children's Fund (unicef) and the Sports Committee of the German National Parliament. Currently, Tim is General Secretary of the European Sport Economics Association (ESEA) and Principal Investigator in a DFG-funded project on labour market effects of sports related public expenditures.
