Pamela Wicker is an Acting Professor for Sport Organizations at Bielefeld University, Germany. Previously, she was employed at the German Sport University Cologne where she was awarded a PhD in 2009. In 2015, she completed her Habilitation and earned the associated title of 'Private Lecturer' (PD). From 2011 to 2012 she was employed as a Senior Lecturer in Sport Management at Griffith University, Australia. Pamela's main research interests include (non-profit) sport organizations, the societal relevance of sport, sport participation and public health, as well as sport and the natural environment.

Pamela is Associate Editor of European Sport Management Quarterly, Sport Management Review, and the Journal for Study and Teaching in Sport Sciences. She serves on the Editorial Board of another six journals (Journal of Sport Management, Journal of Sports Economics, International Journal of Sport Finance, European Journal for Sport and Society, Managing Sport and Leisure, Journal of Sport & Tourism), and reviews articles and research proposals for a wide range of international journals and organizations. Currently, Pamela serves as Vice-President (President-Elect) of the European Sport Economics Association (ESEA).
