Dr. Paul Downward is Reader in Sports Economics in the Sport Policy and Management Research Group of the School of Sport Exercise and Health Sciences at Loughborough University. He is also the author of two research-textbooks on sports economics (The Economics of Professional Team Sports with Alistair Dawson, and Sports Economics, with Alistair Dawson and Trudo Dejonghe). He has undertaken consultancy projects for a variety of UK sport bodies, including UK Sport and Sport England, as well as various governing bodies. He is a founding editorial board member of the Journal of Sports Economics, as well as serving as the Associate Editor for European Sport Management Quarterly. He is also on the editorial boards of Sport Management Review and the Journal of Sport and Tourism. He has given a number of number of keynote presentations; notably on the social -scientific analysis of health and life-style at the ECSS annual conference in Belgrade, at workshops organised before the FIFA World cup in Germany, and numerous international workshops on the economic approach to sports participation in Germany, Spain and the Netherlands. Dr Downward has also served on UK Sport's Research Advisory Group, and currently serves on UEFA's Research Grants

Committee.
