

President Prof. Dr. Pamela Wicker



Pamela Wicker is a Professor for Sport Management and Sport Sociology at Bielefeld University, Germany. Previously, she was employed at the German Sport University Cologne where she was awarded a PhD in 2009. In 2015, she completed her Habilitation and earned the associated title of 'Private Lecturer' (PD). From 2011 to 2012 she worked as a Senior Lecturer in Sport Management at Griffith University, Australia. Pamela's main research interests include (non-profit) sport organizations, the societal relevance of sport, sport participation and public health, as well as sport and climate sustainability.

Pamela has published over 150 articles in journals with peer review. She is Associate Editor of European Sport Management Quarterly, Sport Management Review, European Journal for Sport and Society, and the Journal for Study and Teaching in Sport Sciences. She serves on the Editorial Board of another seven journals (Journal of Sport Management, Journal of Sports Economics, International Journal of Sport Finance, International Journal of Sports Marketing and Sponsorship, Managing Sport and Leisure, Journal of Sport & Tourism, Sport und Gesellschaft [Sport and Society]), and reviews articles and research proposals for a wide range of international journals and organizations. Currently, Pamela serves as President of the European Sport Economics Association (ESEA).
