He has had visiting appointments at University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign, University of Paderborn and University of Zurich. Rob is currently Adjunct Professor at University College, Cork. Rob's current research interests are mainly into the workings of professional sports labour markets. He has published over 70 articles in peer reviewed journals and topics include audience demand for sports and sports betting markets. Rob is co-editor of *Economic Inquiry*, with responsibility for papers in sports economics, and he is on the editorial boards of *Journal of Sports Economics* and *International Journal of Sport Finance*. Rob is a past President of the North American Association of Sports Economists and is currently President-Elect of the European Sports Economics Association (ESEA).
